From the February 28, 2023 Stated Meeting

At the stated February 28, 2023 meeting, the Session acted on the following items:

- The Presbyterian Women's Birthday Luncheon to be held April 23, 2023 after worship service.
- The opening of the Cinderella Shop in the West Center March 17-19 and March 24 & 25.
- Rev. Lucy Youngblood to preach March 12, 2023 in Rev. Brearley's absence.
- A donation of \$2000 to the Presbyterian Disaster Assistance (PDA) in direct support of the earthquake humanitarian relief in Turkey and Syria. This will be funded through the Nixon Fund.
- A request from Rev. Brearley to invite Gavin Meek and Susan Holton March 19 to give a Minute for Mission on the Pastor Nominating Committee.
- The first meeting of the Church Officer Nominating Committee (CONC) will convene March 1, 2023.
- The 200th Anniversary steering committee has recommended that community gifts be made to Sumter United Ministries and Habitat for Humanity on behalf of our 200th anniversary celebration. Both organizations will present project proposals for use of the gift.

The Session requests that you keep the PNC in your constant prayers as the committee begins the arduous but exciting process of finding the pastor that God has already chosen for our church.
