#### **CONGREGATIONAL MEETING**

Two at-large members are to be nominated by the congregation. If anyone has a member they would like to nominate, the nominee must understand the duties and responsibilities of the Church Officer Nominating Committee and have previously agreed to serve if elected. In addition, the Session has approved asking the congregation at that meeting to vote on the following:

- 1. That each class of the Diaconate be composed of five (5) Deacons, a change from seven (7) Deacons presently;
- 2. That the Congregational Nominating Committee nominate four (4) at-large church members, including a youth, to be elected to the coming year's Congregational Nominating Committee. (The Session will elect two Elders, and the Diaconate will elect one Deacon to complete the committee.)
