NEW GUIDELINES FOR WORSHIP & CHURCH ACTIVITIES

Based on the current CDC guidelines and considering the recent increased COVID cases, the Reopening Task Force recommended, and Session approved, the following guidelines be implemented:

- We strongly encourage that those who are fully vaccinated wear a mask and we continue to request that any individual who is not vaccinated, including children 2-years-old and up, wear a mask during all church activities.
- 2. Offering will be collected at the end of each worship service with Ushers standing with collection baskets at the exit doors.
- 3. Sunday School classes will continue following the mask recommendation above.
- 4. Youth Fellowship will begin on September 12 following the mask recommendation above.
- 5. Faithful Families and other upcoming ministries will be put on hold until further notice.


SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS
