#### A CHURCH MEMBER

I recently read a short book by church leadership guru and consultant, Thom Rainer, entitled, I am a Church Member. Rainer was compelled to write the book after his research revealed over half of all conflict in church had to deal with members arguing over their personal preferences. Rainer hopes and prays the book will cause all of us church members to rethink our attitude about church membership, and to understand we are there to serve, not necessarily to be served. In his book, Rainer presents six pledges he believes all church members should strive to claim in order to help their own congregation thrive in ministry and mission. The first pledge is below.

Pledge #1: I will be a functioning church member. I like the metaphor of membership. It's not membership as in a civic organization or a country club. It's the kind of membership given to us in I Corinthians 12, "Now you are the body of Christ, and individual members of it." (I Cor. 12:27). Because I am a member of the body of Christ, I must be a functioning member, whether I am an "eye," and "ear," or a "hand." As a functioning member, I will give. I will serve. I will minister. I will evangelize. I will study. I will seek to be a blessing to others. I will remember that "if one member suffers, all the members suffer with it; if one member is honored, all the members rejoice with it." (Cor. 12:26-27)

Pledge #1 presents us with the foundational principle of church membership - "I belong." We belong to God and to one another. To belong means that we are there for each other, we acknowledge our differences but still work together towards our greater purpose in serving Christ. We give, we serve, we study and we share the Good News with one another and the world around us. When Jesus told Peter, "on this rock I will build my church," thankfully he wasn't asking only Peter to do the building, he was asking every one of his disciples. Those disciples are you and I. It's a great calling, but we didn't sign up for a cake walk. We signed up to follow Jesus. Let's keep on putting one foot in front of the other as we grow into functioning church members. Amen?




