

## "YOU ARE INVITED TO A WEDDING!"

(Names of Jesus in the New Testament - Part Seven)

<u>Introduction:</u> One of the first names given to Jesus in the New Testament is "The Bridegroom". Why is Jesus called "the Bridegroom"? (John 3:28-30 / Matthew 9:14-15)

## I. THIS NAME MEANS JESUS IS MARRIED TO {HIS CHURCH}!

- 1. You were chosen by Jesus to be His bride. (II John 1)
- 2. You are deeply loved by the bridegroom. (Ephesians 5:25 / Ephesians 3:18-19 / Acts 20:28)
- 3. You will never be divorced by the bridegroom. (Hebrews 13:5b / Isaiah 54:10 / Romans 8:38-39)

## II. THIS NAME MEANS JESUS HAS PLANNED A BIG WEDDING FOR HIS BRIDE IN HEAVEN!

\*Matthew 25:11-13

Note: The reception planned in Heaven after the rapture is called "the marriage supper of the Lamb"! (Revelation 19:9)
