## "DAMAGED, BUT NOT DISCARDED"

(Counseling from the Pulpit - Session Ten)
(Jeremiah 18:1-10)

Note: There are many forms of {abuse} which damage people of all ages...

I. I MAY BE DAMAGED, BUT NOT {DESTROYED}

Biblical Examples: {Joseph / adulteress woman / Mary Magdalene}

My counsel: "Believers should desire to {live} and not die."

II. I MAY BE DAMAGED, BUT NOT {DISCARDED}

Biblical Examples: {David / Samaritan Woman / Rahab / Peter}

My counsel: "To fall or fail does not have to be spiritually  $\{fatal\}$ !"

III. I MAY BE DAMAGED, BUT NOT {DEFINED}

<u>Biblical Examples</u>: {Jabez / John Mark / Thomas / John the Baptist / Moses}

My counsel: "You are  $\{not\}$  defined by what others say or do to you."
