Note: There are many forms of {abuse} which damage people of all ages...

I. I MAY BE DAMAGED, BUT NOT {DESTROYED}

Biblical Examples: {Joseph / adulteress woman / Mary Magdalene}

My counsel: "Believers should desire to {live} and not die."

II. I MAY BE DAMAGED, BUT NOT {DISCARDED}

Biblical Examples: {David / Samaritan Woman / Rahab / Peter}

My counsel: "To fall or fail does not have to be spiritually {fatal}!"

III. I MAY BE DAMAGED, BUT NOT {DEFINED}

*Luke 7:24-27 *I Corinthians 1:26-29

Biblical Examples: {Jabez / John Mark / Thomas / John the Baptist / Moses}

My counsel: "You are {not} defined by what others say or do to you."
