

## “FROM HIS RESURRECTION TO HIS ASCENSION” (The Biography of Jesus – Part Three)

**Note:** The New Testament records seven times Jesus prophesied His Resurrection (*John 2:18-22*)!

### I. JESUS’ RESURRECTION IS {SUPERNATURAL}.

*\*John 19:38-42      \*Luke 24:36-43      \*John 20:24-27      \*John 20:3-8*

*\*I Corinthians 15:1-4*

**Note:** Jesus was dead, but He is alive again.

### II. JESUS’ RESURRECTION IS INFALLIBLY {SUBSTANTIATED}.

*\*Acts 1:1-3      \*I Corinthians 15:3-8      \*Mark 16:9-14*

**Note:** The Resurrection appearances of Jesus were to different people, at different locations, and different dates and times, over forty days.

### III. JESUS’ RESURRECTION IS {SPIRITUAL}.

*\*John 20:19      \*John 20:26      \*Luke 24:30-31      \*Revelation 1:18      \*Romans 8:34*

**Note:** There is a difference between being resuscitated and being resurrected.

### IV. JESUS’ RESURRECTION IS {SYMBOLIC}.

*\*I Corinthians 15:17-20      \*I John 3:2      \*Philippians 3:20-21      \*Luke 24:50-51*

*\*Acts 1:9-11      \*John 5:28-29      \*Revelation 20:6      \*Revelation 3:20*

**Note:** The Ascension of Jesus explains His absence from the world.
