"WHEN YOU DON'T KNOW WHAT TO DO - PRAY"

(Great Prayers in the Bible – Week Two)

<u>Introduction</u>: Jehoshaphat was king of Judah in 896 B.C. Three large armies are attacking. He was afraid and did not know what to do! (II Chronicles 20:1-12 / Corinthians 10:11)

I. JEHOSHAPHAT SOUGHT THE LORD!

Note: One way to demonstrate sincerity is fasting!

II. JEHOSHAPHAT PRAYED A BIBLICAL PRAYER!

Note: Jehoshaphat is quoting a promise God made to Solomon.

Question: "Can prayer change events on earth?"

III. GOD SPOKE TO JEHOSHAPHAT!

Note: God often speaks in the midst of tribulation!

IV. JEHOSHAPHAT DEMONSTRATED HIS FAITH!

Note: The victory started when believers started praising God!

<u>Conclusion</u>: This chapter begins with Jehoshaphat and Judah afraid and it ends with their enemies afraid. (II Chronicles 20:27-29)
