

## “WHEN YOU DON’T KNOW WHAT TO DO - PRAY”

(Great Prayers in the Bible – Week Two)

Introduction: *Jehoshaphat was king of Judah in 896 B.C. Three large armies are attacking. He was afraid and did not know what to do! (II Chronicles 20:1-12 / I Corinthians 10:11)*

### I. JEHOSHAPHAT SOUGHT THE LORD!

*\*II Chronicles 20:3-4      \*Psalm 50:15      \*Amos 4:6-11      \*Jeremiah 29:13*

Note: One way to demonstrate sincerity is fasting!

### II. JEHOSHAPHAT PRAYED A BIBLICAL PRAYER!

*\*II Chronicles 7:12-16      \*John 15:7*

Note: Jehoshaphat is quoting a promise God made to Solomon.

Question: “Can prayer change events on earth?”

### III. GOD SPOKE TO JEHOSHAPHAT!

*\*II Chronicles 20:13-19      \*Isaiah 30:20-21*

Note: God often speaks in the midst of tribulation!

### IV. JEHOSHAPHAT DEMONSTRATED HIS FAITH!

*\*II Chronicles 20:20-24      \*Mark 11:22-24      \*Hebrews 11:1      \*I John 5:14-15*

Note: The victory started when believers started praising God!

Conclusion: *This chapter begins with Jehoshaphat and Judah afraid and it ends with their enemies afraid. (II Chronicles 20:27-29)*
