

"WHO WANTS TO BE BLESSED?"

(Unexpected Ways to be Blessed - One)

<u>Note</u>: "The Sermon on the Mount" is one of the most famous sermons ever preached. The preacher was <u>Jesus</u>! The first eight statements are called "The Beatitudes"! They are <u>unexpected</u>, <u>universal</u>, and <u>ageless</u> ways to be blessed by God.

I. BLESSED ARE THE POOR...

 *Matthew 5:3
 *III John 2
 *Proverbs 10:22
 *I Chronicles 29:12

 *Philippians 4:19
 *I Timothy 6:9-10
 *James 2:5

1. This is <u>not</u> referring to <u>financial</u> poverty.

<u>Note</u>: Jesus did <u>not</u> say "blessed are the <u>financially</u> poor".

- 2. This <u>is</u> referring to <u>spiritual</u> humility.
- **<u>Note</u>**: A person can be spiritually bankrupt and not even realize it.
