<u>Context</u>: In the Parable of the Lost Sheep, the sheep represents s<u>inners</u>. The shepherd represents Jesus.

I. THE {HELPLESS} SHEEP

1. Sheep can be foolish.

Note: Sheep are very social.

2. Sheep are <u>defenseless</u>.

Note: Sheep are very insecure and fearful.

3. Sheep lack a sense of direction.

Note: Sheep are followers.

II. THE {COMPASSIONATE} SHEPHERD
