(Romans - Chapter Eight)

Introduction: Romans chapter 8 was written to encourage believers to "walk in the Spirit". The Holy Spirit is mentioned 19 times in this chapter.

### I. THERE IS NO {CONDEMNATION}.

Note: The sins of believers were judged on the cross.

### II. THERE IS NO {DESPAIR}.

Note: There is no despair in pain, in prayer, in problems, nor in provisions!

### III. THERE IS NO {FEAR}.

Note: Believers should walk by faith and not by fear!

### IV. THERE IS NO {SEPARATION FROM GOD}.

\**John 10:28-29*

Note: No person can "walk in the Spirit" unless that person has the Spirit. (*Romans 8:9*)

Conclusion: This chapter begins with no condemnation. It ends with no separation. In between it declares that all things are working for good to those who love God.
