"HOW TO OVERCOME TEMPTATION" (Famous Chapters in the Bible – Ten) (Luke – Chapter Four)

Introduction: Jesus is our Savior and also our <u>example</u>! (I Peter 2:21)

I. JESUS ENTERED THESE TEMPTATIONS "FILLED WITH THE HOLY SPIRIT"

*I Peter 5:8 *Ephesians 4:27 *Galatians 5:16

- 1. Satan often attacks <u>after</u> a spiritual high. (Moses)
- 2. Satan often attacks when we are tired, alone, or hungry. (Elijah)

Note: Do not forget that Satan is studying believers!

II. JESUS ANSWERED EVERY TEMPTATION WITH THE WORD OF GOD

*Luke 4:2-4	*Luke 4:5-8	*John 8:44	*Luke 4:9-12
*I John 4:1	*Revelation 12:11 *Matthew 12:43-45	*Psalm 119:11 *John 8:30-32	*Ephesians 6:17
*Luke 4:13			

- 1. Satan is such a <u>liar</u>! (look at verses 3 & 6)
- 2. Satan uses Scripture. (verses 10-11) (many cults use Scripture)
- 3. When Satan leaves, he will return.

<u>Note</u>: Jesus obviously had these scriptures memorized and understood how to use them. It is also important to note that Jesus spoke out loud the Word to Satan!

III. JESUS RECEIVED HOLY SPIRIT POWER AFTER HE OVERCAME THE TEMPTATIONS OF SATAN

*Luke 4:14-22 *James 1:12 *Luke 4:31-37

*John 15:5 *II Corinthians 5:17

<u>Conclusion</u>: You cannot have a testimony without enduring the test! You cannot have the blessing without the Blesser! God cannot expand your audience without the anointing!
