"WHAT IS A STEWARD?"

(Stewardship Lessons - Two)
(I Corinthians 4:2)

Review: God has a plan of stewardship. 1) The Bible tells us {how much} to give (Leviticus 27:32). The word "tithe" is 10%. 2) The Bible tells us {where} to bring the tithe Malachi 3:10). 3) The Bible tells us {when} to bring the tithe (I Corinthians 16:2). 4) God's plan of stewardship promises great blessings to those who consistently obey Him (Malachi 3:10-12). 5) God's plan of stewardship requires faith (II Corinthians 5:7)!

I. GOD <u>REQUIRES</u> STEWARDSHIP OVER <u>ALL</u> HE GIVES US!

Note: A "steward" is someone who manages another person's property!

II. WISE STEWARDS {SAVE} FROM ALL GOD GIVES THEM!

*Genesis 41:53-57 *Job 14:1

1. You should save for {emergencies / needs}.

Note: All wise financial counselors recommend 6-12 months minimum!

2. You should save for things you {desire}.

Note: It is wise to have short-term and long-term savings!

3. You should save for {retirement}.

Note: Seek employment with a company which assists with retirement and disability.

III. WISE STEWARDS MANAGE FINANCES WITH A {BUDGET}.

Note: A proven plan for savings is the 10/10/80 Plan.

*Luke 6:38 *Numbers 23:19-20

Conclusion: Every believer needs a wise accountability partner (Ephesians 5:21).

"BEING GOOD STEWARDS of OUR MONEY"

- (1) <u>It is Required by God!</u> You <u>must</u> keep a record of <u>every</u> dollar spent! (I Corinthians 4:2) "A budget tells you where your money <u>will go</u>". But, it is impossible to budget carefully without a record of where all went." (this is the reason I use checks! Record!)
- (2) <u>It is Essential to God's special blessings!</u> (*Luke 16:10-12*) A person MUST learn to manage every dollar wisely. God can not trust us with much, if we are not good stewards of little.
