"THE GREATEST MYSTERY OF HISTORY"

(The Story of Christmas - Part one)

Introduction: A word used by the Holy Spirit to describe the incarnation is {mystery} (I Timothy 3:16)! That same word is used to describe the {gospel} (Ephesians 6:19). Jesus said that believers can understand the mysteries of the {kingdom} (Matthew 13:10-11)!

I. THE OLD TESTAMENT TELLS US THAT JESUS IS COMING!

- 1. It tells us {HOW} Jesus will come! (Genesis 3:15 / Isaiah 7:14 / Galatians 4:4-5)
- 2. It tells us {<u>WHY</u>} He will come! (*Genesis 3:21 / Exodus 12:3-7 / John 1:29 / I Peter 1:18-20*)
- 3. It tells us {WHERE} He will come! (Micah 5:2 / Matthew 2:1-6)
- 4. It tells us {HOW MESSIAH WILL DIE}. (Isaiah 53:5-7 / Numbers 21:6-9 / John 3:14-15)
- 5. It tells us {WHEN} He will be born! (Daniel 9:25)

Note: The words "Messiah" and "Christ" mean "The Promised One"!

II. THE GOSPELS TELL US THAT JESUS HAS COME!
