

## "WHAT MAKES THE NAME "CHRIST" SO SPECIAL?" (Names of Jesus in New Testament – Part Two)

<u>Introduction:</u> The name "Christ" in NT is "Messiah" in the OT. The name Christ means "the promised one"! (Matthew 16:13-18)

## I. THIS NAME MEANS {GOD KEEPS HIS PROMISES}!

\*Daniel 9:25-27 \*John 1:20 \*John 1:40-41 \*John 4:25-26 \*John 4:39-42

Note: Jesus had to fulfill all Old Testament prophecies to be "the Christ"!

## II. THIS NAME MEANS {GOD PROVIDES SALVATION FOR ALL}!

Note: Jesus Christ had to be both {worthy and willing} to be our Savior!

\*Revelation 20:4

**Conclusion:** This name means believers can trust God to keep all His other promises as well! (Acts 16:31)
