

## "JESUS, THE AUTHOR and FINISHER of our FAITH" (Names of Jesus in the New Testament – Part Four)

Introduction: Jesus is called "the author and finisher of our faith" (Hebrews 12:2). In Revelation 1:8, Jesus is called "Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the ending". Jesus is also called "the first and the last" (Revelation 2:8).

## I. THIS NAME MEANS THAT ALL OF CREATION EXISTS AND CONSISTS BY JESUS!

Note: The word "consists" means "held together and kept in harmony"!

## II. THIS NAME MEANS THAT SALVATION, FROM CONCEPTION TO COMPLETION, IS BY JESUS!

Note: When Jesus saves a person, He gives them eternal salvation!

\*Hebrews 7:25

<u>Note</u>: When Jesus saves a person, He <u>continues to sanctify</u>.

\*II Corinthians 5:17 \*Philippians 3:20-21

**Conclusion**: "If a person does not continue in the faith, what does it mean?" (I John 2:19)
