Communication

Definitions:

- Communication: an *exchange of information* or news, or a *Connection* between two people/entities.

Examples:

Jesus (Matthew 26, 39)



Vision

(Purposed Seed)

Definitions:

- The ability to **SEE** or **SIGHT**
- Something **imagined** or **pictured** in the mind (Faith?)
- A **dream** or part of a **supernatural experience**

Examples:

Job 33, 14-16

Genesis 37, 5 & 9 (Joseph's dream)



Inspiration

(Fuel)

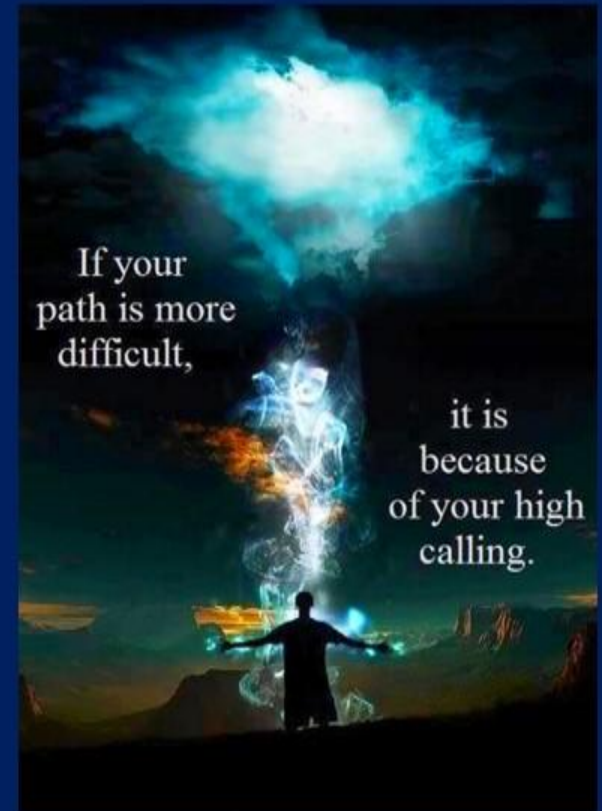
Definitions:

- The act of *influencing*
- The action or *power* of moving the *intellect* and *emotions*
- Divine *influence* or action on a person believed to *qualify* them to receive and *communicate sacred revelation!*
(Communication & Vision)

Examples:

Jeremiah 32, 39-40

1st Peter 5, 10

Connection

(Grafting IN)

Definitions:

- Connection: a relationship of *personal intimacy (family ties)*
- Kindred: a group of people *related to one another* like a family, tribe or clan. Share same *beliefs*, attitudes and feelings.
- Scion: a person born into a rich important family. A “living” portion of one plant “*grafted in*” to another to support and promote its growth!

Examples:

1st John 1, 3 & 7

Romans 11, 17
