DEVOTION GUIDE

Verse of the Week: “Whoever does God’s will is my brother, sister, and mother.” (Mark 3:35, CEB).

Daily Prayer: Almighty and everlasting God, ruler of all things in heaven and on earth: in mercy, hear the prayers of your people and grant us peace throughout our lives; through Jesus Christ our Lord, Amen.

Introduction to this week’s Immerse New Testament Scripture readings: This week’s readings take us into the Book of Acts (also written by Luke) and the history of the early church. Note the work of the Holy Spirit in the life of the church as the continuation of the Holy Spirit’s work through Jesus:

Questions for Reflection/Journaling/Discussion:

1. How did you respond to this week’s message? What insights and questions did it raise for you?
2. How does following Jesus make people seem “crazy” to the rest of the world? Note how the world responds to the early church and its ministry in the Book of Acts.
3. What are some other “crazy” things that the world believes about Christians? In what sense can we be even “crazier” in the way of Jesus?
4. You may also respond to the questions in the Immerse: Messiah reading plan card.

Intercessory Prayer Guide:

Monday - Pray for our community and for an increase of Christian witness among all the churches.

Tuesday - Pray for those who may reject Jesus, that their hard hearts would be softened to hear the gospel.



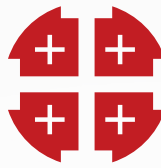
