## Nic at Night Message Notes

**Text: John 3:1-21** 

## **Devotion Guide**

#### Daily Devotional Guide Nic at Night

**Verse of the Week:** Jesus replied, "Very truly I tell you, no one can see the kingdom of God unless they are born again." (John 3:3 NIV)

**Daily Prayer:** Holy Spirit of God, invisible like the wind, we do not see you moving among us, but the effect we see—come to our hearts: that we may be renewed and reborn. Open our minds: that we may perceive your kingdom. Lift up our eyes to where the cross of Christ stands for our healing: so may we believe, and in believing not die but have eternal life; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

**Introduction to this week's Scripture readings:** This week's texts look at several conversion stories in the New Testament. Note the various ways and processes by which people come to be "born from above" and become followers of Jesus.

#### **Daily Scripture Readings:**

Monday – John 3:22-36 - John the Baptist testifies about Jesus

**Tuesday** – John 4:1-42 - The Samaritan Woman (next week's sermon text)

**Wednesday** – Acts 8:26-40 - The Ethiopian Eunuch

Thursday –Acts 9:1-19 - The Conversion of Saul

Friday – Acts 10:1-23 - The Conversion of Cornelius (part 1)

Saturday – Acts 10:24-48 - The Conversion of Cornelius (part 2)

#### Questions for Reflection/Journaling/Discussion:

- 1. Reflect on this week's message about Nicodemus and the new birth. What did you learn? What questions did it raise? What challenged you or struck you as important for your life?
- 2. In the conversion stories in this week's readings, how would you describe the process by which each person came to faith in Jesus? How did the Holy Spirit use others to help "midwife" a new birth?
- 3. Consider your own conversion story. What was the process by which you experienced new birth in Christ? How are you growing toward maturity as a disciple of Jesus?

#### **Intercessory Prayer Guide:**

**Monday -** Pray for those living in darkness who need new birth in Christ.

**Tuesday -** Pray for those who are culturally Christian and yet have not experienced new birth. Pray for an awakening to the leading of the Holy Spirit.

Wednesday - Pray for those concerns listed on the TLUMC prayer list this week.

**Thursday -** Pray for teachers and ministers, and others who are responsible for bringing the Word of God to people.

**Friday -** Pray for our troubled world and for the Spirit to show you ways to bring more of the light of Christ into it.

Saturday - Pray for our worship services on Sunday and for all who will attend.




#### **Seeking Meal Providers**
