#### Verse of the Week:

#### **Daily Prayer:**

- 5. What does it mean to you to be a "beloved disciple" of Jesus? What do you think might be some characteristics of a "beloved disciple?"

### **Intercessory Prayer Guide:**


**Monday -** Pray for those who have yet to encounter the story of Jesus, and that the Holy Spirit would give you courage to tell your story of faith in him.
