Devotion Guide

Verse of the Week: “They devoted themselves to the apostles’ teaching, to the breaking of bread and the prayers (Acts 2:42).

Daily Prayer: Lord, you created your church to reflect your glory, your Word, and your mission. Help us to not simply go to church but to be the church wherever we find ourselves. Amen.

Introduction to this week’s Scripture readings: This week’s readings focus on each of the seven marks of the transformational church:

Monday - Acts 1:1-11 - You will be my witnesses (Missionary mentality)

Tuesday - Ephesians 4:1-16 - Gifts for leading (Vibrant leadership)

Wednesday - Hebrews 10:19-25 - Provoking one another to love and good deeds (Relational intentionality)

Thursday - 1 Timothy 2:1-8 - Prayerful dependence

Friday - Isaiah 6:1-8 - The presence of God (Worship)

Saturday - Matthew 25:31-46 - Mission in the way of Jesus (Mission)

Questions for Reflection/Journaling/Discussion:

1. How did you respond to this week’s message? What insights and questions did it raise for you?
2. Where do you see these seven marks at work at TLUMC? What can we improve upon? How will you be part of making that vision a reality?
3. Craft a vision of the kind of church that God wants using these seven marks. What would such a church look like? How would it be different than the institutional church to which we have become accustomed?
4. As you look at this list of marks of the transformational church, what areas of your own life do you need to work on? How might you partner with God to become more of the person God has called you to be?

Intercessory Prayer Guide:

Monday - Pray for TLUMC, our vision, and our future as a church.

Tuesday - Pray for the United Methodist Church.

Wednesday - Pray for those requests listed on our TLUMC prayer list and prayer wall.

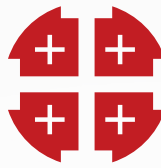
