Daily Prayer:

Questions for Reflection/Journaling/Discussion:

- 1. Looking back on this week's message: what stood out to you? What challenged you? What new insights did you gain? What will you do differently as a result?
- 2. When you read stories about faithful people in the Scriptures, what common characteristics do they display? Define "faithfulness" based on your reading this week.
- 3. The people described in this week's readings were faithful to God even when it might have cost them their lives. How do you suppose that kind of faithfulness was cultivated in them?
- 4. Reading this week's Scriptures, what is God saying to you about your own faithfulness? What will you do with what God is saying to you through his Word?
- 5. What temptations and trials are you facing right now? How can this lesson in faithfulness help you overcome them in the power of the Spirit?

Intercessory Prayer Guide:

Monday - Examine your own faithfulness to God and ask the Holy Spirit to increase the fruit of faithfulness in your life.

Tuesday - Pray for our youth and young adults, that they may be faithful in the midst of a culture that "will not tolerate sound teaching."

Wednesday - Pray for those in our church who are in need, especially those who may be struggling with faith (use the weekly prayer list).

Thursday - Give thanks to God for those who have influenced your faith.

Friday - Pray for a new openness in our culture to hearing the truth of God.

Saturday - Pray for our worship services on Sunday and that TLUMC would continue to be a church where people increase their faith and faithfulness.
