Daily Devotional Guide Week 8: Self Control

Verse of the Week:

“Those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. If we live by the Spirit, let us also be guided by the Spirit.” (Galatians 5:24-25, NRSV)

Daily Prayer:

Heavenly Father, I pray that I may live this day in your presence and please you more and more. Lord Jesus, I pray that this day I may take up my cross and follow you. Holy Spirit, I pray that this day you will fill me with yourself and cause your fruit to ripen in my life: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. Holy, blessed and glorious Trinity, three persons in one God, have mercy upon me. Amen. - John Stott

Daily Scripture Readings:

Monday – Proverbs 25:26-28

Thursday – 2 Peter 1:3-11

Tuesday – Titus 1:5-9

Friday – 1 Corinthians 9:24-27

Wednesday – 2 Peter 1:3-11

Saturday – 2 Timothy 1:3-7

Questions for Reflection/Journaling/Discussion:

1. Looking back on this week's message: what stood out to you? What challenged you? What new insights did you gain? What will you do differently as a result?
2. How would you define “self-control” according to this week's message and Scripture readings?
3. Where in our culture do you see people struggling with self-control? How can we be a help and resource to others who cannot seem to say “no?”
4. In our own words, describe what Paul means when he says we are to “crucify the flesh with its passions and desires.” How do we do that?
5. In what areas of life do you struggle with self-control? How can the Spirit and your faith community help you in that struggle?

Intercessory Prayer Guide:

Monday - Confess the areas in your own life where you struggle with self-control. Ask the Spirit to make you mindful and grant you strength.

Tuesday - Meditate on the John Stott prayer above. Make it a point to memorize it and pray it at the beginning of each day.

Wednesday - Pray for those in our church who are in need, especially those who may be struggling with issues of self-control (use the weekly prayer list).

Thursday - Pray for those struggling with addictions.

Friday - Pray for the day ahead and ask God to help you exercise control over your speech and your actions.

Saturday - Pray for our worship services on Sunday and that TLUMC would continue to be a church where people increase their capacity for self-control.
