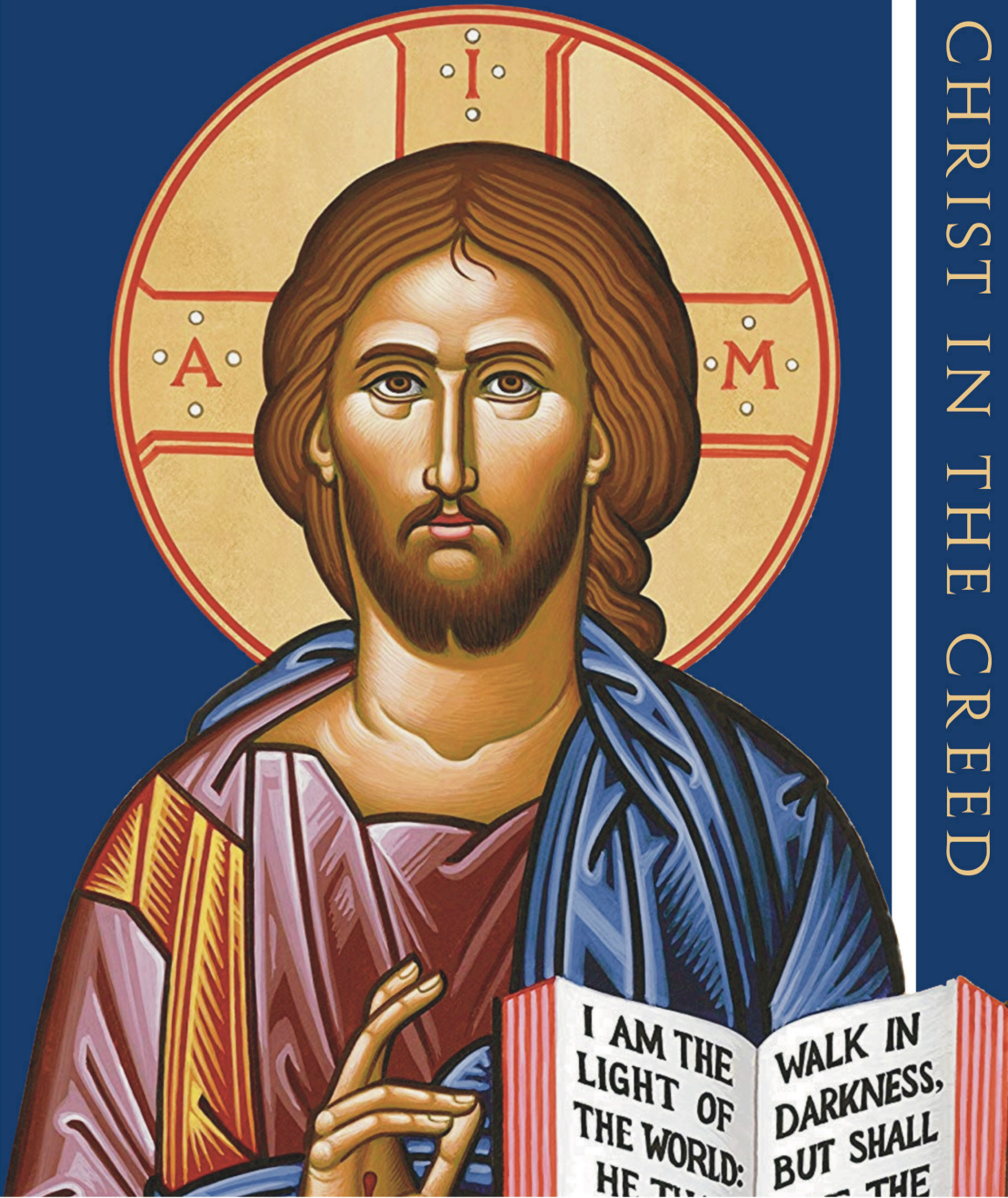

Children's Worship is offered at both the 8:00AM and 11:00AM services. Children enter sanctuary and sit with parents. They leave when dismissed and then are returned in time for communion with their families.

Looking for Sunday School Classes? September through May we offer Sunday school classes for all ages. The children's classes are located in the Faith Forest (Wesley Hall). DEVOTION GUIDE

Verse of the Week: “The angel replied, ‘The Holy Spirit will come over you and the power of the Most High will overshadow you. Therefore, the one who is to be born will be holy. He will be called God’s Son.’” (Luke 1:35, CEB).

1. How did you respond to this week’s message? What insights and questions did it raise for you?
2. How does this understanding of Jesus’ incarnation change your perception of Advent and Christmas? How would you describe it to someone who is new to Christian faith?
3. Have you experienced new birth in Christ? Have you been filled with the Holy Spirit? Describe how your life is different as a result. If you are seeking new birth, simply ask God and experience his forgiveness, love, and life-altering grace. Talk to a trusted Christian friend or pastor about what new birth and life in the Spirit means for you.

Intercessory Prayer Guide:

Monday - Pray for all who have yet to experience new birth in Christ.

Tuesday - Pray for an outpouring of the Holy Spirit during this Advent and Christmas season.

Wednesday - Pray for those requests listed on our TLUMC prayer list and prayer wall.

Thursday - Pray for opportunities to share your faith with someone today.

Friday - Pray for the Spirit to strengthen you to follow God’s will.

Saturday - Pray for Sunday’s worship service; that the Spirit might move in powerful ways among us.

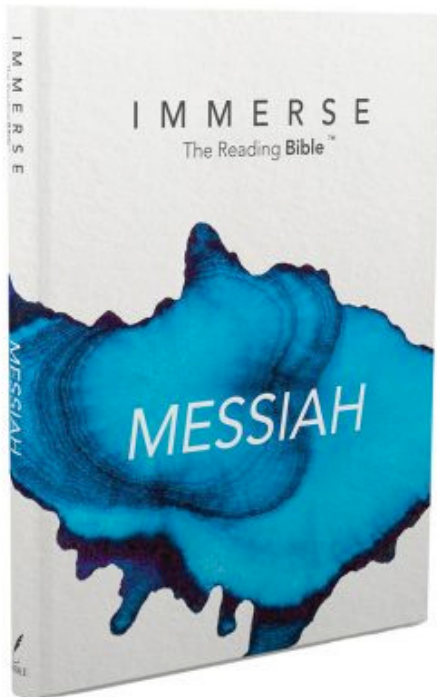
