# Daily Devotional Guide Do You Want To Be Made Well?

**Verse of the Week:** "My Father is still working and I am working, too. (John 5:1-18 CEB)

**Daily Prayer:** Lord, help us to rise when you call. Grant us the strength to follow you and to embrace life with its attendant burdens, griefs, and joys. Amen.

Introduction to this week's Scripture readings: This week's texts take us through the rest of John 5 and into John 6 in preparation for next week's message on the Bread of Life.

**Daily Scripture Readings:** 

Monday – John 5:1-18 - Revisiting the story of the healing at the pool Tuesday – John 5:19-30 - The work of the Father and the Son Wednesday – John 5:31-47 - Jesus' testimony and Scriptures Thursday – John 6:1-15 - Feeding the 5,000 Friday – John 6:16-25 - Jesus walks on water Saturday – John 6:26-59 - The Bread of Life

#### **Questions for Reflection/Journaling/Discussion:**

- 1. Reflect on this week's message and Jesus' conversation with the man at the pool and the Jewish leaders. What did you learn? What questions did it raise? What challenged you or struck you as important for your life?
- 2. Jesus says that he is doing what his Father is doing. What does his ministry tell you about the nature and character of God the Father?
- 3. Do you want to be made well? In what areas in your life is Jesus asking you that question?
- 4. As you read this week's texts in preparation for next Sunday, what questions do they raise for you? What do they tell you about Jesus?


