Text: John 6:35-59



Devotion Guide

Daily Devotional Guide The Bread of Life

Verse of the Week: “I am the bread of life. Whoever comes to me will never go hungry, and whoever believes in me will never be thirsty.” (John 6:35 NIV)

Daily Prayer: Feed us, Jesus, and fill us with hope. Free us, Jesus, from the pursuit of food that does not satisfy. Gather up the pieces of our lives, that nothing may be lost. Sustain and nourish us with the bread of life so that we may have the strength and confidence to live the abundant life you promise us. Amen.

Introduction to this week's Scripture readings: This week's texts explore the image of bread as a tangible sign of God's provision, both spiritually and physically. May you be sustained by the bread of life as you read and pray this week!

Daily Scripture Readings:

Monday – Exodus 12:1-30 - The first Passover

Tuesday – Exodus 16:1-36 - God provides manna in the desert

Wednesday – 1 Kings 17:7-16 - Elijah and the widow at Zarephath

Thursday – Isaiah 55:1-13 - Eat what is good, feasting on the Word of God

Friday – 1 Corinthians 10:1-22 - Israel's history and the body of Christ

Saturday – 1 Corinthians 11:17-34 - Concerning the Lord's Supper

Questions for Reflection/Journaling/Discussion:

1. Reflect on this week's message on John 6. What did you learn? What questions did it raise? What challenged you or struck you as important for your life?
2. As you read the Scriptures this week, what images and thoughts come to mind as you consider Jesus' teaching on the bread of life? How is Jesus' statement that he is the bread of life revealed in these Scriptures?
3. Describe your approach to Holy Communion. How do you prepare to receive it each week? What does it mean to you? How does this week's reading and sermon enhance your understanding of communion?

Intercessory Prayer Guide:

Monday - Pray for our upcoming UMC General Conference, for wisdom and guidance for delegates and for the future of the church.

Tuesday - Pray for those who are hungry, both spiritually and physically.

Wednesday - Pray for those concerns listed on the TLUMC prayer list this week.






