- **4.** 1 & 2 Corinthians focus on several conflicts in the church, but Paul's ultimate answer to the problems of this world is the promise of resurrection. How does 1 Corinthians 15 connect with your learning from this week's sermon?
- **5.** You may also respond to the questions in the Immerse: Messiah reading plan card.


