DEVOTION GUIDE

Questions for Reflection/Journaling/Discussion:

1. How did you respond to this week’s message? What insights and questions did it raise for you?
2. When have you or someone close to you experience miraculous healing or change? What was the long term effect on your life? How did it change your relationship with God?
3. When have you asked for healing and not received it in the way you hoped? How did that affect your relationship with God?
4. 1 & 2 Corinthians focus on several conflicts in the church, but Paul’s ultimate answer to the problems of this world is the promise of resurrection. How does 1 Corinthians 15 connect with your learning from this week’s sermon?
5. You may also respond to the questions in the Immerse: Messiah reading plan card.

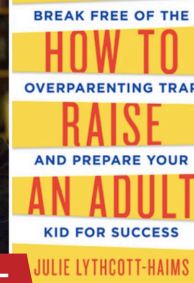
