Text: John 4:4-42



Devotion Guide

Daily Devotional Guide Living Water

Verse of the Week: Jesus answered, “Everyone who drinks this water will be thirsty again, but whoever drinks from the water that I give will never be thirsty again. The water that I give will become in those who drink it a spring of water that bubbles up to eternal life.” (John 4:13-14 NIV)

Daily Prayer: We thank you and praise you, O God, that how ever we may thirst, what ever we may need to satisfy our souls, you offer it freely and abundantly in Christ; So we drink deep of the living water and, as we draw from your wells, we seek to pass the cup to others who, like us, are thirsty for your grace. Amen.

Introduction to this week’s Scripture readings: This week’s texts focus on the image of “living water” throughout the Bible. Notice how they connect to Jesus’ conversation with the woman at the well.

Daily Scripture Readings:

Monday – Psalm 1 - The righteous are like trees planted by streams of water

Tuesday – Ezekiel 47:1-12 - A vision of living water from the Temple

Wednesday – Isaiah 55:1-13 - Come to the waters

Thursday – John 7:37-39 - All who are thirsty, come to Jesus

Friday – Zechariah 14:1-9 - Living water and the restoration of God’s people

Saturday – Revelation 22:1-5 - Living water from the throne of God

Questions for Reflection/Journaling/Discussion:

1. Reflect on this week’s message and Jesus’ conversation with the Samaritan woman. What did you learn? What questions did it raise? What challenged you or struck you as important for your life?
2. Based on your reading this week, how is the image of living water used throughout the Bible? How does that image fit the person of Jesus?
3. How would you define spiritual thirst? In what areas of your life do you experience it? How might the living water Jesus promises quench that thirst?

Intercessory Prayer Guide:

Monday - Pray for those have a spiritual thirst in their lives.

Tuesday - Pray for those who are outcast from their families or from society because of their choices or actions. Pray for restoration and hope.

Wednesday - Pray for those concerns listed on the TLUMC prayer list this week.

Thursday - Pray for the areas in your life in which you experience dryness and a need for the living water Jesus promises.

Friday - Pray for those who do not have regular access to clean water. Ask God to reveal how you might help provide them with real living water.

Saturday -Pray for our worship services on Sunday and for all who will attend.
