Devotion Guide

Daily Devotional Guide The Posture of a Disciple

Verse of the Week: "For I have set you an example, that you also should do as I have done to you" (John 13:15 NRSV)

Daily Prayer: Jesus, you demonstrated the posture of humility by picking up a basin and towel, kneeling in the dust with the broken, and being stretched out on a cross. Help us to follow your example by changing our posture to serve others. Amen.

Introduction to this week's Scripture readings: This week's texts focus on the disciple's posture of humility and servanthood. The Scriptures express the need for humility and care in our relationships with others.

Daily Scripture Readings:

Monday – Colossians 3:12-17 - The disciple's spiritual clothing Tuesday – James 4:1-10 - Humble yourselves before the Lord Wednesday – Mark 9:30-37 - The first and the last Thursday – Psalm 25:1-10 - God leads the humble in what is right Friday – Matthew 25:31-46 - Serving others is serving Christ Saturday – Philippians 2:1-11 - Following the example of Jesus

Questions for Reflection/Journaling/Discussion:

- 1. Reflect on this week's message on Jesus' washing the disciples' feet. What did you learn? What questions did it raise? What challenged you or struck you as important for your life?
- 2. As you read the Scriptures this week, how would you define humility? How would you define servanthood? In what ways is humility a key character trait of a disciple of Christ?
- 3. In what situations and with what persons might you need to change your posture to better represent Jesus?

Monday - Pray for those who live on the margins of our society.

Tuesday - Pray for those whom you will meet today, that you may serve them well.
