3. How does Mark reveal Jesus' concern for the least, the last, and the lost? How does Mark's portrait of Jesus convict you as a disciple?
4. What practices can you engage in during the Lenten season that enable you to serve others more intentionally?
5. You may also respond to the questions in the *Immerse: Messiah* reading plan card.






