Devotion Guide

Daily Devotional Guide The Way, The Truth, and The Life

Verse of the Week: Jesus answered, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me" (John 14:6 CEB)

Introduction to this week's Scripture readings: This week we encourage you to engage in a careful reading of Jesus' "Farewell Discourse" in the Gospel of John. Pay attention to how each text answers the question, "What key points is Jesus trying to embed in his disciples before his departure?".

Monday – John 13:31-14:31 - The First Discourse: "Yet in a little while..." Tuesday – John 15:1-17 - The Second Discourse: "Abide in me." Wednesday – John 15:18-6:4a - The Third Discourse: "The world will hate you." Thursday – John 16:4b-33: The Fourth Discourse: "It is better for you..." Friday – John 17:1-26 - The Sage's Prayer Saturday – 1 John 2:28-3:6 - Remaining in Christ

Questions for Reflection/Journaling/Discussion:

- 1. Reflect on this week's message on Jesus as the way, the truth, and the life. How would you describe the ways in which Jesus is the way, truth, and life in your own life?
- 2. As you read the Scriptures this week, what are the key points that Jesus is trying to teach his disciples before his departure? How are those points im portant for disciples today?
- 3. How are you "abiding" in Christ on a daily basis? What habits help you abide? What practices might help you to abide even more closely with him?

Tuesday - Pray for Christians around the world who are persecuted for their faith.
