Devotion Guide

Daily Devotional Guide A Prayer for Truth and Unity

Verse of the Week: "This is eternal life: to know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom you sent" (John 17:3 CEB).

Daily Prayer: O God, we pray for your church universal, that you would be pleased to fill it with all truth, in all peace. Where it is corrupt, purify it. Where it is in error, direct it. Where it is right, establish it. Where it is divided, reunite it. For the sake of him who died and rose again, and ever lives to make intercession for us, Jesus Christ, your Son, our Lord. Amen.

Introduction to this week's Scripture readings: This week we focus on the church and on the Scriptural call for unity among believers. The texts focus on the basis for that unity and how to achieve it with God's help.

Daily Scripture Readings:

Monday – 2 Chronicles 30:1-12 - Hezekiah brings reform and unity to Judah

Tuesday – Psalm 133 - The God-pleasing nature of unity

Wednesday – Ephesians 4:1-16 - Unity in the Body of Christ

Thursday - 1 Peter 3:8-22 - Be of one mind

Friday - Romans 12:1-21 - We belong to each other

Saturday – 1 Corinthians 1:10-17 - Be restored with the same mind and purpose

Questions for Reflection/Journaling/Discussion:

- 1. Reflect on this week's message on unity and truth. Based on the message and on this week's readings, what would you say are the basic criteria for Christian unity?
- 2. As you read the Scriptures this week, what common threads do you see? How might Christians best seek unity with one another?
- 3. Jesus talks about truth being the ground of unity. What is the truth about Jesus that has been revealed so far in the Gospel of John?

Monday - Pray for the unity of the church around the world.

Tuesday - Pray for Christians who are in conflict with one another.
