Text: John 9:1-7



Devotion Guide

Daily Devotional Guide The Man Born Blind

Verse of the Week: “The man said, ‘Lord, I believe.’ And he worshipped Jesus” (John 9:38).

Daily Prayer: Gracious and holy Father, give me wisdom to perceive you, intelligence to fathom you, patience to wait for you, eyes to behold you, a heart to meditate upon you, and a life to proclaim you, through the power of the Spirit of Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen. (St. Benedict)

Daily Scripture Readings:

Monday – John 9:1-7 **Tuesday** – John 9:8-17 **Wednesday** – John 9:18-34
Thursday – John 9:35-38 **Friday** – John 9:39-41 **Saturday** – John 10:1-18

Questions for Reflection/Journaling/Discussion:

1. Read John 9:1-41. What character(s) do you identify with in the narrative? Why?
2. Read John 5:1-18. What similarities and differences do you see between that narrative and the healing of the blind man in John 9? What is the significance of your observations?
3. There is not a single instance of a blind person receiving sight in the Old Testament. Such an ability is only ascribed to God or the messiah (Exod 4:11; Ps 146:8; Isa 29:18; 35:5; 42:7). In the New Testament, none of Jesus disciples are involved in restoring sight, only Jesus. What does this suggest about Jesus' identity?
4. How is God working in your life to remove blindness?

Intercessory Prayer Guide:

Monday - Pray for the well-being of the mission, ministry, and witness of the United Methodist Church and Tri-Lakes United Methodist Church.

Tuesday - Pray for the leaders of our government at all levels.

Wednesday - Pray over the TLUMC prayer requests sent out via email.

Thursday - Pray for the poor throughout the world from our local area to distant countries.

Friday - Recount the blessings in your life. Let this reflection take you into a time of worship and thanksgiving through prayer.

Saturday - Pray for the movement of the Holy Spirit during tomorrow's worship services.

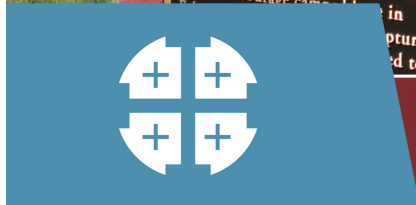

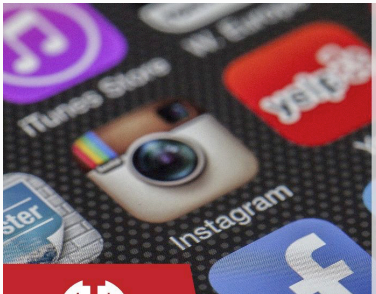

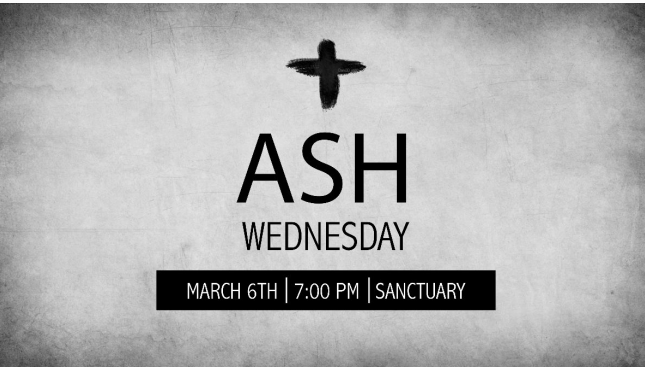
