Daily Prayer

IN THIS VIRAL SEASON PLEASE...

1) Maintain some personal space. We are a church that loves to hold hands to sing after the benediction and greet one another with a hearty handshake or hug. We encourage you instead to “elbow bump,” wave, or tip your hat to one another on Sunday morning instead. **2) Communion protocols:** There’s really no completely sanitary way to serve Holy Communion without some touching. We encourage you to use your best judgment when receiving the sacrament. You can always receive just the bread (which is distributed by servers with sanitized hands) and skip dipping the bread into the cup. Christ is present in the sacrament regardless. If you choose not to commune due to health concerns, that’s ok, too. **3) Wash your hands.** We have hand sanitizer available throughout the building, but there is no substitute for soap and warm water. Wash for 20 seconds. **4) Pray.** There’s a lot of fear in our culture these days and the presence of an unknown virus ramps up the anxiety. Stay calm, pray, and take care of yourself. We will get through this and be back to normal soon. And if you do get sick, let us know so that we can be praying for you!

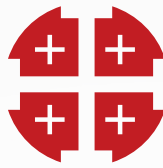
