Text: John 13:36-38

Devotion Guide

Daily Devotional Guide Peter Denies Jesus

Verses of the Week: "A servant of the high priest, a relative of the one whose ear Peter had cut off, said to him, 'Didn't I see you in the garden with him?' Peter denied it again, and immediately a rooster crowed" (John 18:26-27).

Daily Prayer: "Oh God, you are my God; eagerly I seek you. My soul thirsts for you, my flesh faints for you, as in a barren and dry land where there is no water. I long to gaze upon you in your holy dwelling that I might know you as you truly are" (adapted from Psalm 63:1-2).

Introduction to this week's Scripture readings: Though Peter failed by his denial of Jesus, Jesus remained faithful to Peter. This week's readings remind us that God's love and faithfulness toward us are unconditional. God's love for us does not fluctuate in coordination with our faithfulness. Indeed, God loves us in the midst of our sin and failures not after we clean ourselves up.

Daily Scripture Readings:

Monday - Romans 5:1-8 - Jesus died for us while we were sinners

Tuesday - Titus 3:3-8 - God saves us because of his mercy not our righteousness

Wednesday - Isaiah 55:6-9 - God's ways are not like ours

Thursday – Psalm 103 - The Lord does not treat us as our sins deserve

Friday – Ephesians 2:1-10 - Though once dead we are now alive because of God's mercy, not our good works

Saturday – John 18:33 - 19:16 - Reading in preparation for Sunday morning

Questions for Reflection/Journaling/Discussion:

- 1. Reflect on a time when you misjudged another person or situation. How was your perception corrected?
- 2. What are some ways you think we make God according to our image (i.e., that of human beings) and thus distort his nature and character?
- 3. What are some ways for us to correct our perception of God?
- 4. On your worst day, when you utterly fail at being a disciple, do you struggle to believe that God loves you no less than on your best day? Be honest!

Intercessory Prayer Guide:

Monday - Pray for those who feel rejected by God because of their failures as a disciple to experience the unconditional love of God.

Tuesday - Pray for an opportunity to show God's unconditional love to someone who desperately needs it.

Wednesday - Pray over the requests listed in this week's TLUMC prayer list.

Thursday - Reflect on Romas 5:8. Allow your reflection to lead you into a time of worship and thanksgiving for God's unconditional love.

Friday - Pray for those who have a distorted view of God's character and nature.


Saturday - Pray for a powerful movement of the Holy Spirit during our worship services tomorrow.
