Text: John 21:15-25

### **Devotion Guide**

#### The Restoration of Peter

Verse of the Week: "After saying this, Jesus said to Peter, 'Follow me" (John 21:19b).

**Daily Prayer:** O Good Shepherd, seek me out, and bring me home to your fold again. Deal favorably with me according to your good pleasure, until I may dwell in your house all the days of my life, and praise you forever and ever with them that are there. Amen (St. Jerome).

**Introduction to this week's Scripture readings:** This week's readings are filled with people who resisted God's call, made immoral choices, and were unlikely candidates for fulfilling God's purposes by our standards. And yet, all were used by God. The readings conclude with a reminder that God qualifies the called; he does not call the qualified.

Tuesday - Joshua 2

Wednesday - Judges 6

Thursday - 2 Samuel 11

Friday - Matthew 9:9-13

Saturday - 2 Corinthians 2:12-3:6

#### Questions for Reflection/Journaling/Discussion:

- 1. Reflect on the various people God called and used in the Bible. Are there any patterns that stand out to you?
- 2. What unqualified person that God called in the Bible do you resonate with the most?
- 3. Have you ever resisted God's call because you didn't think you were worthy or qualified? How did you work through it (or not)?
- 4. How is the Holy Spirit speaking to you as you reflect on this idea that God qualifies the called and doesn't always call the qualified?




#### Prime Timers Wings Over The Rockies Museum Tour
