

## Text: Nehemiah 2:11-20; 1 Peter 2:1-10

# **Devotion Guide**

### **A Firm Foundation**

**Verse of the Week:** "The God of heaven is the one who will give us success, and we his servants are going to start building..." (Nehemiah 2:20).

**Daily Prayer:** Lord God, help me this day to live according to your Word, with my faith grounded on the cornerstone of Christ Jesus. Amen.

**Introduction to this week's Scripture readings:** This week's texts are all about building on a firm foundation. Daily reading of Scripture is an important discipline for those whose lives are built on the "controlling story" of God's Word!

### Daily Scripture Readings:

Monday – 1 Peter 2:1-10 - Christ the cornerstone Tuesday –Matthew 7:24-27 - Wise and foolish builders Wednesday – Luke 14:25-34 - The cost of building disciples Thursday – Psalm 118 - The head of the corner Friday – 1 Corinthians 3:10-20 - No foundation but Christ Saturday – 2 Timothy 2:1-19 - "The Lord knows who are his"

### **Questions for Reflection/Journaling/Discussion:**

- 1. Reflect on this week's message on building on a firm foundation. What questions or insights did it raise for you?
- 2. Nehemiah conducted a thorough inspection and then inspired the people to build. What in your life needs further inspection and what needs to be rebuilt?
- 3. This week's text focus on building on a firm foundation. How is Christ the foundation of your life? What are some concrete ways in which you build your life on him?
- 4. What "controlling stories" do you see guiding the people around you? How might the story grounded in Christ change their lives?

### Intercessory Prayer Guide:


**Monday** -Pray for those whose lives were lost in war and conflict, for their families, and for the day when war will be no more.
