Text: Matthew 5:1-12; James 1:1-12

Devotion Guide

The Test of Faith

Verse of the Week: "My brothers and sisters, think of the various tests you encounter as occasions for joy. After all, you know that the testing of your faith produces endurance. Let this endurance complete its work so that you may be fully mature, complete, and lacking in nothing" (James 1:2-4).

Daily Prayer: Lord, grant me your wisdom today so that I may pass the test of faith and reflect your glory in all that I say and do. In Christ, Amen.

Introduction to this week's Scripture readings: This week you will read through the entire Epistle of James as a way of learning the major themes. Pay special attention to how James imparts wisdom to his readers.

Daily Scripture Readings:

Monday – James 1:1-27 Tuesday – James 2:1-26 Wednesday – James 3:1-12 Thursday – James 3:13-4:10 Friday – James 4:11-5:6 Saturday – James 5:7-20

Questions for Reflection/Journaling/Discussion:

- Reflect on this week's message. What questions or insights did it raise for you?
- 2. Jot down some of the major themes of the Epistle of James. How would you summarize the message of the Epistle in your own words?
- 3. What tests are you facing today? How will you listen for God's wisdom? What are some steps you can take to discern what God is saying?
- 4. What is one area of your life in which you may be "double-minded?" How might you offer that area to God for transformation?


