# Devotion Guide

## The Spitting Image

**Verse of the Week:** “You must be doers of the word and not only hearers who mislead themselves” (James 1:22).

**Daily Prayer:** Father God, thank you for your word made flesh in Jesus. Lord Jesus, help me to follow you in all your ways. Holy Spirit, empower me to not only hear the word but to do it. Amen.

**Introduction to this week’s Scripture readings:** This week’s readings are all about hearing and doing the word of God and our vocation as human beings.

### Daily Scripture Readings:

**Monday** – Genesis 1:26-2:17 - The purpose of humanity

**Tuesday** – Psalm 8 - What is a human being?

**Wednesday** – Romans 2:1-16 - The doers of the law are justified

**Thursday** – Luke 11:27-28 - True blessedness

**Friday** – Psalm 1 - The righteous and the wicked

**Saturday** – Matthew 7:24-27 - The wise and foolish builders

### Questions for Reflection/Journaling/Discussion:

1. Reflect on this week’s message. What questions or insights did it raise for you?
2. How would you describe James’ understanding of the “word?” How does the gospel, the Scriptures, and the word made flesh in Christ inform your understanding of the “word?”
3. How would you summarize the gospel? How does one conform one’s life to the good news of Christ?
4. What identity struggles have you faced? How does this week’s message help you to understand your true identity?

**Tuesday** - Pray for people wrestling with their identity.

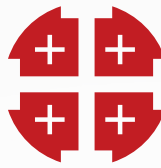
