Text: Nehemiah 11:1-2; Acts 1:1-9



Devotion Guide

The Edge of Empire

Verse of the Week: “But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth” (Acts 1:8 NIV).

Daily Prayer: Jesus, grant me the courage today to move outside the walls and expand your kingdom wherever I go. Amen.

Introduction to this week’s Scripture readings: This week’s texts are all about the Kingdom of God and how it expands.

Daily Scripture Readings:

Monday – Matthew 13:1-23 - The Parable of the Sower

Tuesday – Matthew 13:24-52 - More parables of the Kingdom

Wednesday – Matthew 28:16-20 - The Great Commission

Thursday – Acts 28:17-31 - Paul proclaims the Kingdom

Friday – Revelation 11:15-19 - The kingdoms of the world become God’s kingdom

Saturday – Ephesians 2:11-22 - Breaking down the dividing wall

Questions for Reflection/Journaling/Discussion:

1. Reflect on this week’s message. What questions or insights did it raise for you?
2. How would you describe the kingdom of God? What would the world look like if God’s reign and was fully realized?
3. How are you expanding the kingdom of God in your daily life and in your inter actions with others? Give some examples.
4. Who are the people who you consider to be “them.” How might you overcome the wall between you to offer them the good news of Christ and his kingdom?

Monday -Pray for God’s kingdom to come on earth as in heaven.

Tuesday - Pray for healing and reconciliation among Christians.

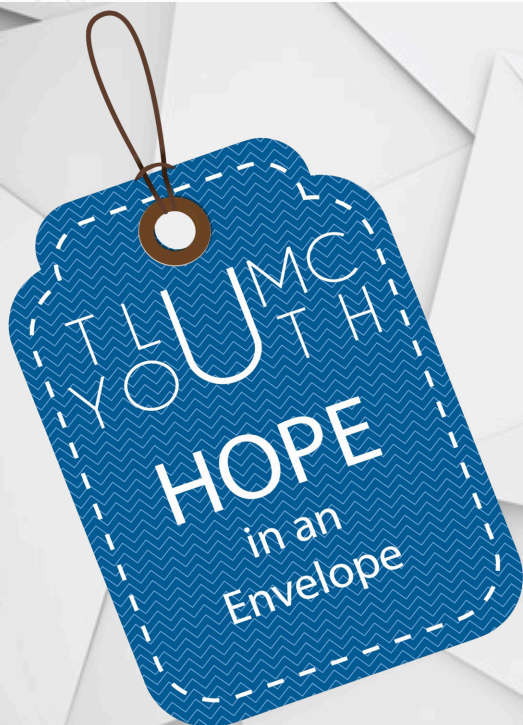
