Text: James 3:1-12; Matthew 10:16-25

Devotion Guide

Taming the Tongue

Verse of the Week: "Think about this: a small flame can set a whole forest on fire. The tongue is a small flame of fire, a world of evil at work in us. Because of it, the circle of life is set on fire." (James 3:5b-6)

Daily Prayer: Speaking God, you give us your Word and teach us how to live the life of your kingdom. Guard our speech and help us to always speak in ways that are true, kind, and helpful. Amen.

Introduction to this week's Scripture readings: This week's readings focus on the nature of speech on how controlling the tongue is a vitally important spiritual discipline for disciples of Jesus.

Daily Scripture Readings:

Monday - 1 Peter 3:8-17 - Keep from evil speaking

Tuesday – Matthew 15:1-20 - What comes out of the mouth comes from the heart

Wednesday – Proverbs 18:1-8 - The words of the mouth are deep waters

Thursday – Colossians 4:2-6 - Your speech should be gracious

Friday – Ephesians 4:17-32 - Say what is helpful

Saturday – Titus 3:1-8 - Speak respectfully to all

Questions for Reflection/Journaling/Discussion:

- 1. Reflect on this week's message. What questions or insights did it raise for vou?
- 2. Reflect on a time when you said or wrote something you later regretted. What was the result? How can you avoid it in the future?
- 3. According to Jesus, our speech is a reflection of what is in our hearts. How might you better prepare your heart each day so that you speak in ways that honor God and build up others?
- 4. Consider making your own list of rules for right speaking. Write them down somewhere that you can refer to them as you begin each day.

Tuesday - Pray for children and their families who attended VBS this week. Wednesday - Pray for those concerns listed on the TLUMC prayer list and prayer wall.


