Devotion Guide

Examples of Arrogance

Verse of the Week: "It is a sin when someone knows the right thing to do and doesn't do it" (James 5:17).

Daily Prayer: Holy God, may the soil of our hearts be fertile ground in which your word may take root. Speak to us today the word we need to hear, whether it is a word of comfort or conviction, courage or correction. Plant it deep within us, and bring it to fruition, for the sake of the Word incarnate. Amen.

Introduction to this week's Scripture readings:

This week's readings relate to various themes from James 4:11-5:6. Many of the readings are shorter. Read them slowly. Prayerfully reflect on the words allowing the Holy Spirit to speak to you through them.

Daily Scripture Readings:

Monday – Matthew 7:1-6 Tuesday – Proverbs 27:1 Wednesday – Psalm 90:12 Thursday – 1 Timothy 6:17-19 Friday – Luke 12:15-34 Saturday – James 5:7-20

Questions for Reflection/Journaling/Discussion:

- 1. Do you think arrogance is considered a virtue or a vice in our culture?
- 2. James 4:11-5:6 contains three sections (4:11-12; 4:13-17; 5:1-6). How does each section expose an arrogant attitude?
- 3. Read James 4:11-5:6 once more. Which of the three sections speaks to you and challenges you most?

Intercessory Prayer Guide:


Monday - Pray that the church will be an example by refraining from speaking evil about one another and judging one another.
