Text: James 2:14-26; Matthew 7:15-21

## **Devotion Guide**

### **Faith and Works**

**Verse of the Week:** "As the lifeless body is dead, so faith without actions is dead" (James 2:26).

**Daily Prayer:** Creator God, you created us in your image to live your purpose as our vocation in the world. Help us to daily to bear the fruit of the gospel through our words, deeds, thoughts, and actions. In the name of Christ, who came to set us free for joyful obedience, Amen.

**Introduction to this week's Scripture readings:** This week's readings focus on faith and how we live it out in action. Notice how James' Epistle summarizes and simplifies the teaching of Jesus and the witness of other biblical texts.

### **Daily Scripture Readings:**

Monday - Hebrews 11 - The "faith" chapter

Tuesday – Matthew 25:31-46 - Judging faith in action

Wednesday - Romans 6:1-11 - New life in Christ

Thursday - Ephesians 2:1-10 - Saved by grace for good works

Friday - Habakkuk 2:1-4 - The righteous live by faith

Saturday – Galatians 5:2-25 - Faith working through love

### Questions for Reflection/Journaling/Discussion:

- Reflect on this week's message. What questions or insights did it raise for you?
- 2. Based on the Scripture readings and this week's message, write down definitions for "gospel," "faith," and "works." How did your study confirm or alter your understanding of these familiar terms?
- 3. Jesus teaches that faith must be demonstrated in service to God and others. If someone were to accuse you of being a Christian, would there be enough evidence based your actions to convict you?
- 4. Describe the ways in which you are living out your faith in both word and action.

## **Intercessory Prayer Guide:**

**Monday -** Pray for boldness to live your faith more publicly.

**Tuesday -** Pray for churches that are dying, for revival of faith and action.

Wednesday - Pray for those concerns listed on the TLUMC prayer list this week.

**Thursday** -Pray for those who have yet to have faith in Christ.

**Friday -** Pray for the first person you meet today after leaving home whether you know them or not. Ask God to bring them closer in faith.

**Saturday -** Pray for those who will attend worship at TLUMC this Sunday, that they may experience the presence and power of God.


