Text: Daniel 1

Devotion Guide

Strangers in a Strange Land

Verse of the Week: "But Daniel resolved that he would not defile himself with the royal rations of food and wine; so he asked the palace master to allow him not to defile himself. Now God allowed Daniel to receive favor and compassion from the palace master." (Daniel 1:8-9 NRSV)

Daily Prayer: Father God, help me to be both courteous and courageous as I go to work or school this week. Grant me the grace and wisdom to represent you well. In Christ, Amen.

Introduction to this week's Scripture readings: This week's readings give some background to the Book of Daniel from other Old Testament sources, as well as Jesus' own teaching on being both courteous and courageous in a culture hostile to faith.

Daily Scripture Readings:

Monday - 2 Kings 23:1-20 - King Josiah: The Last Reformer

Tuesday – 2 Kings 23:21-37 - The coming disaster of exile

Wednesday – 2 Kings 24 - The fall of Jerusalem

Thursday - 2 Kings 25 - The second invasion and the destruction of the Temple

Friday – Luke 12:4-12 - Courageous confession

Saturday –Daniel 2 - Nebuchadnezzar's Dream

Questions for Reflection/Journaling/Discussion:

- You may want to grab a good study Bible with commentary and maps as you read the account of the fall of Jerusalem and the exile in 2 Kings. What does this story reveal about Israel? About God?
- 2. Exile was the result of the apostasy of God's people. How is God's judgment on his people enacted here? How do some people of faith experience exile today?
- 3. This week's message focused on being strangers in a strange land and engaging a pagan culture with both courage and courtesy. How do you express both of those traits in your life at school or work?
- 4. Daniel 2 takes us deeper into the story. As you prepare for next Sunday's message, make some notes about Nebuchadnezzar's dream. What kinds of dreams do you experience?

Tuesday - Pray for teachers, administrators, and support staff at our local schools. **Wednesday -** Pray for those requests listed on our TLUMC prayer list and prayer wall.




