

Text: Daniel 2

Devotion Guide

The Dream Weaver

Verse of the Week: "God is the one who changes times and eras, who dethrones one king only to establish another, who grants wisdom to the wise and knowledge to those with insight." (Daniel 2:21 CEB)

Daily Prayer: We acknowledge and praise you, Father God. You've given us wisdom and insight and made known to us the mystery of your kingdom. Grant us the courage to live for that kingdom, to live in that story, and to put the kingdoms of this world in perspective as subject to you. Through Christ our Lord, Amen.

Introduction to this week's Scripture readings: This week's readings focus on dreams as revelation in the Scriptures. Daniel 2 has significant parallels with the Joseph story in Genesis, for example. As you read, look for ways in which dreams act as revelations of God and consider how God might still use dreams today.

Daily Scripture Readings:

Monday – Genesis 37:1-20 - Joseph's dreams Tuesday – Genesis 40:1-23 - Joseph interprets dreams Wednesday – Genesis 41:1-32 - Joseph interprets Pharaoh's dreams Thursday – Acts 10:1-23 - Peter's dream Friday – Acts 10:24-48 - The results of Peter's dream & Cornelius' vision Saturday – Daniel 3 - The fiery furnace (next week's sermon text)

Questions for Reflection/Journaling/Discussion:

- 1. Think about some dreams you may have had lately. How do you interpret them? What might God have been saying to you in your dreams? Consider keeping a log of your dreams and look for patterns and symbols.
- 2. Dream interpretation was highly prized in the ancient world. How does the interpretive gift given to Joseph and to Daniel result in their elevation in pagan kingdoms? How are these men used of God to change circumstances?
- 3. This week's message focused on the dream of God's kingdom. How is your life different than the rest of the world because you live in that story?
- 4. Peter's dream opened up a new avenue of ministry. What dreams might God be giving you for reaching the people around you with the gospel?

Intercessory Prayer Guide:

Monday - Pray for God's kingdom to come on earth as it is in heaven.

Tuesday - Pray for those who are troubled with stress.

Wednesday - Pray for those requests listed on our TLUMC prayer list and prayer wall.

Thursday - Pray for "wisdom and might" as you head out into the world today.

Friday - Pray for those with whom you might band together in a small group like Daniel did with his friends.

Saturday - Pray for those who will attend worship at TLUMC this Sunday. Pray that God's Spirit would prompt new people to hear and respond to his Word.




Prime Timers Wolf & Wildlife Center Tour
