The Dangerous Life of Prayer

Verse of the Week: "Daniel knelt down, prayed, and praised his God three times that day, just like he always did" (Daniel 6:10).

Daily Prayer: Listening God, you invite us to commune with you in prayer. Help us to not neglect any opportunity to come to you with our praise, our thanksgiving, our concerns, and our intercessions. Open a window in our lives into which your glory may shine. Amen.

Introduction to this week's Scripture readings: This week's readings focus on the discipline of regular prayer as a practice for enduring "life in Babylon."

Daily Scripture Readings:

Monday - 1 John 5:13-17 - Confidence in prayer
Tuesday - 1 Thessalonians 5:12-24 - Pray without ceasing
Wednesday - Luke 18:1-8 - Persistence in prayer
Thursday - Psalm 37 - Trust in the Lord and do good
Friday - Hebrews 10:19-25 - Drawing near to God
Saturday - Daniel 7 - Daniel's vision (next week's message)

Questions for Reflection/Journaling/Discussion:

- 1. How did you respond to this week's message? What insights and questions did it raise for you?
- 2. How is your prayer life? Is it a daily habit or one you need to develop?
- 3. Daniel followed a daily pattern of praise and prayer "like he always did." Who has a prayer life you admire? What might you learn from them?
- 4. This week's readings invite us to be persistent in prayer. How might you structure your day to include more room for that kind of prayer?

Intercessory Prayer Guide:

Monday - Pray for those who are persecuted for their faith around the world. **Tuesday** - Pray for strength and wisdom to be persistent in daily prayer. **Wednesday** - Pray for those requests listed on our TLUMC prayer list and prayer wall.

Thursday - Pray for those who are lost and wandering without God. **Friday** - Pray for leaders in our world, that they may lead in ways that honor God. **Saturday** - Pray for those who will attend worship at TLUMC this Sunday. Pray that God's Spirit would prompt new people to join us to hear and respond to his Word.




