Devotion Guide

The Son of Man

Verse of the Week: “As I continue to watch this night vision of mine, I suddenly saw one like a human being coming with the heavenly clouds. He came to the ancient one and was presented before him. Rule, glory, and kingship were given to him; all peoples, nations, and languages will serve him. His rule is an everlasting one—it will never pass away!—his kingdom is indestructible” (Daniel 7:13-14).

Daily Prayer: Lord Jesus, as we await your return in glory, help us to follow you and to reflect your glory. Make us a holy people prepared for you. Amen.

Introduction to this week’s Scripture readings: This week’s readings focus on image of the “Son of Man” in both the Old and New Testaments.

Daily Scripture Readings:

Monday - Ezekiel 37:1-14 - The dry bones

Tuesday - Mark 2:23-28 - The Son of Man is Lord of the Sabbath

Wednesday - Matthew 12:38-42 - The sign of the Son of Man

Thursday - Mark 13:1-27 - The coming of the Son of Man

Friday - Mark 14:53-65 - The Son of Man and the Christ

Saturday - John 12:20-36 - The Son of Man glorified

Questions for Reflection/Journaling/Discussion:

1. How did you respond to this week’s message? What insights and questions did it raise for you?
2. In your own words, describe how Jesus is the “Son of Man” Daniel envisioned.
3. Daniel’s vision was a comfort to people at various stages of biblical history. How does it comfort you? Disturb you? Confuse you?
4. How does understanding the use of Daniel in the New Testament enhance your understanding of Jesus and his mission?

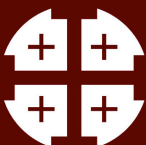

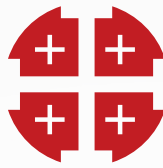
